



2016 PURECOZ RED WINE NAPA VALLEY

Composition:

55% Cabernet Sauvignon, 18% Cabernet Franc, 18% Sangiovese,
9% Merlot

Winemaking:

Punched cap fermented following de-stemming. Each lot was aged
in French oak barrels 40 months prior to blending and bottling.

Tasting Notes:

Ripe currants and black cherries with rhubarb, spice and mineral
subtexts in the aromatics. pureCoz is a rich, intense and complex
proprietary red wine blend dominated by grapes of Bordeaux
origin. In the mouth it is expansive with black fruits, some cherry
and clove accented with ripe well integrated tannins and a complex
yet subtle oak frame. A finely structured wine of elegance and
depth. It is not heavy nor sweet. There is a broadness across the
palate with an exacting balance. It has a bright, refined and pol-
ished finish. Stylistically it shows familiar elements of Meritage and
Super Tuscan wines.

Special Note:

Since its inception with the 2006 vintage this wine was designed to
be more versatile when it comes to food matchups as Meritage
wines tend to be. This may be the single most versatile red wine I
have made in my 40 years of winemaking. It also includes the
rarest of Cabernet Sauvignon clones in this country, which is the
Secret Clone, which migrated from Italy.
