

2010 Petite Sirah

Appellation: Napa Valley (100%)

Composition: 100% Petite Sirah

Winemaking: The fruit was punched cap fermented and barrel aged for 32 months in

selected French and American Oak barrels then blended prior to bottling.

Tasting notes: Classic "Iron fist wrapped in the velvet glove". Powerful and dense

blackberry notes with hints of red raspberries accents. Spice notes add an underlying complexity. Full fruit and floral aromatics. Rich and very full bodied. Powerful and exotic with big structure and yet very polished

on very long finish.

Special Note: This is the first wine made from these young Petite Sirah vines. The

dynamic results defy the notion that young vines won't make complete

and complex wines. Only 72 cases were made!
