



## 2013 M Coz Meritage, Napa Valley

### THE MOST AWARDED MERITAGE WINE IN HISTORY

#### TASTING NOTES

An intense, focused Bordeaux style Meritage with a lineage dating back to the original 1988 vintage. Aromas of currants, berries, plum and spices abound. The well textured palate is rich and full and shows balance, power and elegance. It unfolds through multiple layers to a long, satisfying finish.

#### WINEMAKING NOTES

Each lot was punch cap fermented and finished in barrel where it was aged, unracked. The blend was then made into tank and left to rest and evolve for two months prior to an unfinned bottling.

#### VARIETAL COMPOSITION

55% Cabernet Sauvignon, 18% Cabernet Franc,  
18% Merlot, 9% Petit Verdot

Aged 39 months in French oak

Production: 198 cases

#### COMMENTS

Twenty-five years after its debut, winemaker Mitch Cosentino has continued his tradition of releasing a Meritage only when it equals or surpasses the world's greatest wines made from red Bordeaux varietals. This 2013 M. Coz adheres to this tradition and was bottled at his pureCru Napa Valley Winery in extremely limited quantities from exceptional, hand selected lots.

Prior to release, this 2013 Meritage received Best of Class and Gold Medal awards from some of America's most prestigious wine competitions, including the 2017 San Francisco International Wine Competition under the direction of Anthony Dias Blue. It is ready to enjoy today and will continue to evolve in the bottle through 2025.
